GENERAL:

- A. This Addendum modifies, changes from or adds to the Drawings and Project Manual dated December 06, 2011 and previous Addenda and shall become a part of the Contract Documents.
- B. Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may be cause for disqualification of Bidder.

ADDENDUM ITEMS:

GENERAL

1. NOTICE IS MADE TO ALL BIDDERS THAT THE DRAINAGE STRUCTURES AND PIPING WILL BE PURCHASED DIRECTLY BY THE OWNER AND WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR INSTALLATION.
2. THE MANUFACTURED TRENCH DRAIN SHOWN ON SHEET C-5 IS HERBY DELETED. A PRE-CAST TRENCH DRAIN WILL BE REQUIRED. DETAILS FOR THE PRE-CAST TRENCH DRAIN SHALL BE SUBMITTED AS A SHOP DRAWING AND WILL CONFORM TO THE GENERAL DETAIL SHOWN ON SHEET C-5.

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

Question from J.W. Cheatham, LLC, dated December 19, 2011:

1. Page GC-27, 6.21 requires a designated Safety person at site. Does this person has to spend 100% of his time to Safety or he can be assigned other work? Is this person the same as the Safety Professional mentioned in page 013529-3? Or the safety professional mentioned in page 013529-3 is a 2nd individual who has to do a weekly inspection at the minimum for the duration of the project?

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Q1) RESPONSE:

- a. The intent of the specification is not to have a full time safety individual. However it will be the responsibility of the contractor to conform to the requirements of the Project Manual. Every company has their own policies as to how they achieve their Health and Safety Plan.
 - b. The Safety Representative in the GENERAL CONDITIONS and the Safety Professional are different individuals. The requirement as stated under Section 01 35 29, Article 1.4.C is to have a safety professional or the designated safety representative on site at all times while work is in progress.
 - c. Section 01 35 29, Article 3.1.C, specifies the minimum responsibilities that must be achieved by the safety professional and/or their designated safety representative.
2. Is a temporary fence required or is it at contractors option?

Q2) RESPONSE: The temporary fence is at the discretion of the contractor.

3. Per Section 01 14 00-3 a person with TWICs badge can only escort and be responsible for 5 persons. This will require having more than one person who will require to apply for the TWICs credentials prior to opening of the bids if the owner will not allow enough time after the bid opening to apply for these badges.(as mentioned in pre-bid meeting) Please advise.

Q3) RESPONSE: The Owner will work with the successful bidder for a time period not to exceed 30 days as the TWIC badges are processed and obtained.

4. Per sections 01 14 00-4 -5, there are an extensive requirement for noise and vibration control and reporting. This work is in an industrial area with existing equipment at work. Does this section of specifications apply to this contract?

Q4) RESPONSE: This requirement was deleted with the issuance of Addendum #1.

5. Is a field office trailer required or is it optional?

RESPONSE: The field office trailer is optional. The Owner will make a meeting room available in the Maritime Office Complex (6th floor).
